She would've loved this. You in that dress. Jordan... the food. She'd be all up in Simone's business.

KARA

KARA

DAD

Because I almost lost her. That's how. I was seeing somebody else when I met your mom. It wasn't serious, but... it was convenient.

KARA

Really?

CONTINUED:

DAD

But then your mom came in like a hurricane with that smile and those big ideas and a mouth that didn't know how to whisper.

KARA

DAD

KARA

DAD

KARA
